The Tasks First

These big thinkers like to undertake PHYSICALLY “BIG PROJECTS” – Hitler, Stalin, Mao built huge structures, Mao wanted “A Permanent Revolution” (10’s of millions died), Stalin wanted “Sovietization” of the economy (10’s of millions starved). Hitler, the most berserk of this triad, wanted everything big (structures, wars, adoration, and even his tanks to be 10 times the size of his then current best -- we kid you not) and the damage was colossal.

- It is necessary to sift through the post-Holocaust refuse and identify the psychiatric angle that preceded the Holocaust to nail down causality (We Hope ...).

PGC At A Glance

Boards were spread out on the asphalt. Jack and team hammered the chassis, inserted the boards and it all worked. It still isn’t the end of the story. We, at CSC, have never learned how to charge.
